
How to get there by bus

Canal Walk: services 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 from Angel Row (A2);
Clifton Village: services 1 or 1a from Beastmarket Hill (B2);
Old Basford: services 70 or 71 from Milton Street (T3); **Rock Cemetery and Mapperley Park:** services 15, 16 or 17 from Milton Street (T1 & T2); **Wollaton Park:** service Two from Victoria Centre or 30 from Milton Street (J5).

Please note

- No booking is required for any of the walks and, other than in exceptional circumstances, they will go ahead regardless of the weather.
- Dates, starting times and meeting places are different for each walk, so please check the details carefully.
- Walks average between 1 and 2 miles in length and can take up to 2½ hours, but the pace is very steady.
- Please be mindful of traffic when in areas with narrow footpaths and respect private property when on a walk.

From Trent Bridge to Wilford Street lock, looking at canal features, its history, and links to the adjacent historic sites.
